APPEAL UNDER SECTION 19(1) OF THE RTI ACT BY SMT.VIBHA GOEL AGAINST THE ORDER NO.1619 DATED 25/08/2015 OF CENTRAL PUBLIC INFORMATION OFFICER (CPIO) OF SIDBI REGARDING HER RTI APPLICATION DATED 30/07/2015.

Background:

The Information Seeker Smt.Vibha Goel having her address as 98-Hope Apartments, Sector -15, Part-2, Gurgaon-122001, has preferred the present appeal dated September 11, 2015, received on November 10, 2015, against the order No. 1619 dated August 25, 2015 by CPIO of Small Industries Development Bank of India (SIDBI) in response to her application dated July 30, 2015, seeking information with regard to various aspect of the account of K.K. Organics Pvt Ltd. The information seeker has challenged the said order dated August 25, 2015 of CPIO inter alia, on various grounds alleging that the information provided is not specific, vague and incomplete.

Order:

I have gone through the contents of the Appeal dated September 11, 2015, the application dated July 30, 2015 of the information seeker as also the order passed by CPIO in the matter. It is seen that the information seeker sought information on vide range of issues regarding the account of K.K. Organics Pvt. Ltd with SIDBI, of which she was promoter director.
