**APPEAL UNDER SECTION 19(1) OF THE RTI ACT BY SHRI VASUDEV G
THAKKER AGAINST THE ORDER NO.1888 DATED 01/07/2016 OF CENTRAL
PUBLIC INFORMATION OFFICER (CPIO) OF SIDBI REGARDING HIS RTI
APPLICATION DATED MAY 27, 2016.**

Background:

The Appellant Shri Vasudev G Thakker, 17/B, Shrinand Park, Near Girls High School, Village Bavla, TA.Bavla, Dist.Ahmedabad, Pin 382220, has preferred the present appeal dated July 20, 2016, received on July 26, 2016, against the order No.1888 dated July 01, 2016 by CPIO of Small Industries Development Bank of India (SIDBI) in response to his application dated May 27, 2016, requesting to provide copy of all proceeding documents initiated under SARFAESI Act in respect of industrial property at Changodhar owned by M/s.Golden Foods and copy of public notice issued by SIDBI for auction of the said property. CPIO vide his said order informed that requested information is not available.

Not satisfied with the said order, the appellant has appealed against the said order of CPIO and requested intervention of FAA in providing him the above information for title clearance report of the said property.

I have gone through the contents of the Appeal dated July 20, 2016, the RTI application dated May 27, 2016 of the appellant as also the order No.1888 dated July 01, 2016 passed by CPIO in the matter.

I observe that the CPIO has simply informed that said information is not available without clarifying the reason as to why it is not available. I observe when the account was maintained by the Bank, in normal course information relating thereto should be available.

I allow the appeal and direct the CPIO to provide the information or if not available, reasons thereof. CPIO may decide if any exemption is to be claimed or not. CPIO should dispose of the matter within 15 working days from the date of receipt of the order.
