INFORMATION OFFICER (CPIO) OF SIDBI REGARDING HIS RTI APPLICATION DATED  
20/06/2016.**

**Background:**

The Appellant, Shri Raghava Rachuri, Assistant General Manager (Systems), Small Industries Development Bank of India, MSME Development Centre, C-II, G Block, Bandra Kurla Complex, Bandra (East), Mumbai 400 051 has preferred the present appeal dated August 11, 2016, received on August 12, 2016, against the Order No.1070/RTI-5/1901 dated July 14, 2016 by CPIO of Small Industries Development Bank of India (SIDBI) in response to his application dated June 20, 2016.

Not satisfied with the said order, the appellant has preferred this appeal, requesting intervention of FAA in providing him information sought against column 3(ii)d of his above application.

I have perused the application dated June 20, 2016, order of CPIO dated July 14, 2016 and grounds of appeal dated August 11, 2016 and observe that information seeker has sought copies of PAR of other Officer which cannot be given, as are exempted U/s.8(1)(e) and (j) as rightly claimed by CPIO. Various CIC decisions even do not allow copy of own PAR and only rating is shared with the concerned employee which is the practice in SIDBI also.
