**APPEAL UNDER SECTION 19(1) OF THE RTI ACT BY SHRI ASHOK JOSHI,
AGAINST ORDER NO.1992 DATED OCTOBER 20, 2016 OF
CENTRAL PUBLIC INFORMATION OFFICER (CPIO) OF SIDBI
REGARDING HIS RTI APPLICATION DATED SEPTEMBER 17, 2016.**

Background:

The Appellant, Shri Ashok Joshi, Proprietor Ashok Enterprises, Near Marine Biology, NH-17, Kodibag, Karwar, NK 581303, has preferred the present appeal dated November 16, 2016 against the Order No.1992 dated October 20, 2016 by CPIO of Small Industries Development Bank of India (SIDBI) in response to his application dated September 17, 2016.

Not satisfied with the said order, the appellant has preferred this appeal, requesting intervention of FAA in providing him correct picture/information sought by him in his RTI application.

Observations :

I have gone through the contents of his Appeal dated November 16, 2016, the application dated September 17, 2016 of the appellant as also the order No.1992 dated October 20, 2016 passed by CPIO in the matter. It is observed that vide his above RTI application, the appellant had sought various information from SIDBI relating to his loan under SEMFEX Scheme from KSFC.

I observe that the CPIO has provided the information which was available. However, information w.r.t. his query at Sr.No.3(4) was denied as it did not relate to SIDBI.

Under the provision of RTI Act, information as available is to be provided. CPIO is not expected to sit in judgment on what is correct or wrong. CPIO is not expected to obtain copies from other authorities to be provided to the information seeker. If more information pertains to other public authority, application itself can be transferred,

Order :

In view of the above, I find no infirmity in the order passed by CPIO and appeal is devoid of any merit and accordingly dismissed.
