FIRST APPELLATE AUTHORITY UNDER RIGHT TO INFORMATION ACT (RTI ACT), 2005 SMALL INDUSTRIES DEVELOPMENT BANK OF INDIA (SIDBI) Appeal No.20/2016-17

APPEAL UNDER SECTION 19(1) OF THE RTI ACT BY
DR.SARASWATI GUPTA AGAINST NON RECEIPT OF
INFORMATION FROM
CENTRAL PUBLIC INFORMATION OFFICER (CPIO) OF SIDBI
REGARDING HER RTI APPLICATION DATED SEPTEMBER 16, 2016.

Background:

The Appellant, Dr.Saraswati Gupta, Executive Director, NRI Trust, Karuna Sadan, Sector 11, Chandigarh, has preferred the present appeal dated January 17, 2017 against non receipt of information from CPIO of Small Industries Development Bank of India (SIDBI) in response to her application dated September 16, 2016.

Due to non-receipt of required information from CPIO, the appellant has preferred this appeal, requesting intervention of FAA in providing her requisite information vide her RTI application and also penalizing the CPIO for not providing the information in due time limit.

Observations:

I have gone through the contents of her Appeal dated January 17, 2017, the application dated September 16, 2016 as also the order No.1968 dated October 06, 2016 passed by CPIO in the matter. It is observed that vide her above RTI application, the appellant had sought information regarding number of court cases filed by SIDBI from year 2010 to 2016, number of court cases filed by private individuals or Government Agencies against SIDBI from year 2010 to 2016, total number of court cases from 2010 to 2016 which Bank had filed SLP or Appeals, etc. upto Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, etc.

I observe that the CPIO has provided the requisite information sought by the Appellant and dispatched the Order No.1968 dated October 06, 2016 by Speed Post on October 07, 2016 which was returned with remarks as "No such NRI Trust in Karuna Sadan" exists. The order was again sent to the information seeker by Speed Post on October 21, 2016 at the same address which returned to SIDBI with the above remarks.

I observe that the Appellant has not given her email id, however, the order was posted on RTI MIS portal by the Bank in due course.

Order:

In view of the above, I find that appeal is devoid of any merits and accordingly appeal is dismissed.
