APPEAL No.20/2017-18 BEFORE FIRST APPELLATE AUTHORITY UNDER RIGHT TO INFORMATION ACT (RTI ACT), 2005

Background:

The Appellant, Ms. Dhairya Nihichlani, C-5, Anand Niketan, Avanti Vihar Colony, Post: Shankar Nagar, Raipur, Chattisgarh has preferred the present appeal dated January 31, 2018 under section 19(1) of RTI Act (received by office of First Appellate Authority (FAA) on January 31, 2018) against the Order No.2332 dated January 31, 2018 passed by CPIO requesting intervention of FAA in providing information sought by her in the RTI application.

Observations:

I have gone through the contents of her Appeal dated January 31, 2018, as also the order No.2332 dated January 31, 2018 passed by CPIO in the matter. It is observed that vide her RTI application dated January 01, 2018 the appellant had sought clarification on the guarantee cover exist on the already sanctioned loan amount (i.e. below 100 lacs) under Stand up India Scheme or not.

I observe that CPIO has supplied or informed the appellant as per RTI query and there is no grievance by the Appellant in this regard. Further, now the appellant is requesting for new information i.e. information for the already sanctioned amount (i.e. below 100 lacs) not for the extra amount and if guarantee cover continues on the existing loan then notification may be provided. Since, the Appellant has not any grievance on supply of information as provided by CPIO, the present appeal does not merit consideration.

The RTI mechanism is meant for providing available information which are not exempted under the provisions of RTI Act. The provisions of RTI Act can not be resorted to for seeking clarification or guidance from the CPIO of Public Authority for its action. Further, the Appellant is informed that for seeking of any new information, she may request through separate RTI Application to CPIO as per the provisions of RTI Act and Rules made thereunder.

Order:

I find no infirmity with the impugned order passed by CPIO, the appeal is accordingly disposed of.
