APPEAL No.13 & 14/2018-19 BEFORE FIRST APPELLATE AUTHORITY UNDER RIGHT TO INFORMATION ACT (RTI ACT), 2005

Background:

The Appellant, Ms. Kala S, Flat No. B6, Merry Land Apartment, Near Holy Cross Hospital, Adoor, Dist: Pathanamthitta, PIN: 691533, Kerala, has preferred the present two appeals dated November 02, 2018 under section 19(1) of RTI Act (received by office of First Appellate Authority (FAA) on November 12, 2018) against the letter no. 131272/RTI-5/2490 and 131274/RTI-5/2491 dated October 11, 2018 passed by CPIO requesting intervention of FAA in providing information sought by her in the RTI application.

Observations:

I have gone through the contents of her two Appeals dated November 02, 2018, as also the letter no. 131272/RTI-5/2490 and 131274/RTI-5/2491 dated October 11, 2018 passed by CPIO in the matter. It is observed that vide her two RTI applications dated October 05, 2018, the appellant had sought various information related to Mudra Yojana for the period 2015-18 i.e. (1) How many Mudra Loans are issued by each bank and institutions under Shishu, Kishore, Tarun categories in the State of Kerala under the Prime Minister Mudra Yojana by Regional Rural Banks, Non-Banking Financing Companies and Micro Finance Institutions?, How much amount is granted by way of loan?, and how much amount is disbursed as loan?; (2) How much amount is repaid until now out of the loans disbursed under the categories of Shishu, Kishore, Tarun?; and (3) Who are the beneficiaries of the Mudra loans given by each banks and institutions until today in the districts of Thiruvananthapuram, Pathanamthitta, Ernakulam, Palakkad, Malapuram and Kunnur? and give the address and other details of each such beneficiary?

Not satisfied with the reply given by the CPIO, the Appellant has made this appeal on the grounds that she did not get any information in this regard except a copy of a letter forwarded to Mudra Ltd by SIDBI on October 15, 2018. beneficiary details from the said six districts of Kerala and she may be provided with these information.

I observe that CPIO rightly transferred the two RTI applications to the other Public Authority i.e. The Dy. General Manager & CPIO, MUDRA Ltd, MSME Development Centre, Plot No. C-11, G-Block, Bandra Kurla Complex, Bandra (East), Mumbai- 400051 vide letter no. 131272/RTI-5/2490 and 131274/RTI-5/2491 dated October 11, 2018 under section 6(3) of RTI Act as the information sought pertains to that organization. Further, it is also observed that the said two RTI applications were disposed of by Mudra Ltd vide letter no. 4383/Mudra/RTI/FY 2018 dated November 15, 2018 and 4407/Mudra/RTI/FY 2018 dated November 26, 2018 which is well within the time period and the appellant might have received the same. In view of the above, I do not find any infirmity in the order of the CPIO. Since there is no fees for the appeal as per the provision of RTI Act, the IPOs i.e 33F 567545 & 33F 567546 submitted by the Appellant as fees may be returned back.

Order:

The appeal is accordingly disposed of.
